Mr. LaRue has identified over 170 names of the original WWI Veterans buried in Union Baptist Cemetery. He has researched the names, and matched them with their regiments and units in WWI. These men were buried between 1919 - 1940. This is by no means a complete list of WWI burials in the Union Baptist Cemetery, but a fascinating look at the diverse nature of these Veterans service and sacrifice.
